Pick either oils or acrylics

General Painting Supplies

pallet knife

paper towels

large paper pallet – freezer paper works great from grocery store, or buy one

masking tape

6 – 16X20, (Suggested size), canvas or board board

Acrylic Painting supplies:

plastic wrap

water container

cup for medium

variety of LONG handled brushes, no small brushes, #10 and up, (size of pointer finger)

synthetic brushes work best.

Acrylic retarder and Acrylic Matt Medium

Oil Painting:

plastic wrap

metal paint cups

Canvas, or canvas board (same as above).

variety of LONG handled brushes, no small brushes, #10 and up, (size of pointer finger) boar
bristle brushes work best.

Oil Painting Medium: 1) Artist's professional grade Walnut Alkyd Medium or Gamblin's
Solvent-Free Gel or liquid

NO SOLVENTS, OR UNLABELED OIL MEDIUMS, INCLUDING LIQUIN NOT ALLOWED

Needed colors: Cadmium red medium, Cadmium yellow medium, Ultramarine blue, Titanium
white – large tubes

You can add other colors as well. But no phthalo colors please.

Do not buy paint kits, small tubes and not enough paint and wrong colors.
