Botanical art in colored pencil
Material list

- High quality hot press watercolor paper, 140lb or heavier, 9x12 or bigger. My favorite brands are St Cuthbers Mill Bockingford and Fabriano Artistico. For the techniques we will be using, please make sure your paper is HP (hot press), NOT cold press or rough.
- Sketchbook or drawing paper, 9x12 or bigger
- Tracing paper, my favorite brand is Strathmore, 9x12 or bigger
- Graphite pencils set with a good range of Hs and Bs (I like Faber Castell, Caran D'Ache Grafwood or Staedtler).
- Staedtler kneaded eraser
- Staedtler white eraser
- Tombow MONO zero elastomer eraser
- Erasing shield *
- Sharpener: I recommend a manual one, my favorites are the Derwent Super Point Manual Helical Pencil Sharpener, or the Rapesco 64 (or 74) Desk Top Pencils Sharpener. You will need a very good sharpener for your pencils, so if you have one you like, just make sure it sharpens pencils to a very good point.
- Sandpaper pencil sharpener*
- Ruler
- Embossing tool. There are a few sets you can get, just make sure you have one with a fine point. I like Fine Stylus by Happy Dotting company (available on Amazon). If you are unsure about what embossing tool to get, you can ask me questions during the first class. We'll go over materials then.
- Magnifying glasses, or hand held magnifying glass *
- Divider measuring tool *
- Dusting brush *
- Prismacolor colorless blender pencil
- Prismacolor white pencil PC938
- Colored pencils: I would recommend buying individual pencils and not a set, so you can make sure you have the colors you need. There are several brands of pencils I love, but for this course,

please have **Faber Castell Polychromos**. They have the perfect balance of hardness and pigments. If you'd like to have more colors than what I list, that's great, but please have the colors I ask for. They provide a good starting base if you want to complete botanical art projects. If you are interested in adding to your collection, we will talk about other colored pencils brands in class.
