Applicants with any artistic background are welcome to apply.

- BFA or MFA in Studio Arts, BA or MA in Arts Education, or BA Education or M.Ed. or equivalent work experience
- At least 1 year of classroom teaching experience / classroom management experience
- Ability to design creative, thoughtful and age-appropriate projects/curriculum
- Punctuality, reliability, and flexibility
- Excellent communication and organizational skills
