DAD

It means he does not want to be called a 'Negro.'

MOM

The Whites. The Blacks. We should move back to Manila and leave them to their battles.

DAD

We should not let them deprive us and our children of the opportunities here.

MOM

Opportunities? Moe might have the *opportunity* to die in Vietnam!

DAD

The war will be over long before he is eligible for the draft.

MOM

Our son could be fighting a war that is not ours to fight.

DAD

We are going to become U.S. citizens, and we will be as American as cherry pie.

MOM

And what if you are wrong? And Moe is drafted?

DAD

Then he will face the war, like my brothers did in World War two.

MOM

Never! You'll have to cut out my heart first.

DAD

The Americans fought on our behalf in World War two.

MOM

I don't want my son to be part of any war, Severino.

DAD

If we are fighting for the Americans, then we are on the *good* side.

MOM

Good side....

DAD

The side that won!

MOM

So the Philippines are on the *bad* side, because we never win...?

DAD

This is our home now.

MOM

Our son will not be sacrificed to war.

DAD

If the President believes we should be at war, then we must obey.

MOM

I am a mother, first and foremost.

DAD

seething

You are my wife, first and foremost.

MOM

Dah-DEE. These people try to take advantage of us. They tried to pay me half of my salary because we are married.

DAD

subdued

It was not right/

MOM

I'm not doing half the work as a married woman, so why should they only pay me half?

DAD

It was not right but it was not illegal what they tried to do.
