

Materials for Animals in Many Media

Materials options for this class: Students can choose to explore a variety of materials in this class, or work with a favorite material. Most supplies can be purchased in small, starter amounts. Students can make this choice after the first class and do not need to buy supplies in advance.

Some suggested materials include: a set of acrylic paint in tubes, brushes for acrylic painting, canvases or canvas panels 12" x 16", a set of watercolors (pan watercolors or tubes with a mixing tray), watercolor brushes, wax-resist sticks or masking fluid, 140 lb watercolor paper (can be bought as a large sheet and cut in half or in quarters), toned pastel paper (Canson or Strathmore, suggested colors are grey-blue, grey-green), set of color pencils, set of Prismacolor NuPastels or conte pencils, drawing pencils, kneaded rubber eraser, charcoal pencil, white conte crayon
