## Introduction to Watercolor for Adults with Dani Schechner

## Starter Materials

- ACID free Cold press watercolor paper, smaller pad like 11 x 14
  - Canson or Strathmore 300-400 ok to start
- Watercolor brushes: at least 1 flat 8-12 size, one flat and one round in smaller sizes (2-4)
- 1 pan or set of tubes of watercolor paint with at least these colors:
  - o Burnt sienna
  - Alizarin crimson
  - Cadmium red
  - Yellow ochre
  - Lemon yellow or cadmium yellow
  - o Ultramarine blue
  - Cerulean blue
    - Windsor and Newton, Grumbacher, Reeves, Sennelier, Holbein, Utrecht are all well liked brands
    - You can buy each color in an independent tub or pan or get a kit; student grade kits are ok to start as long as they have the above colors in them
- Watercolor mixing pallet
- 2 cups (glass or plastic)
- Drawing pencil, eraser, sharpener
- Paper towels
- Table salt, rubbing alcohol, vegetable oil
- Q-tips
